Flight Operations Manager

We are seeking a full-time Flight Operations Manager to manage all aspects of a multi aircraft (manned and unmanned) remote sensing flight operations department. The success of the business depends on safety, teamwork and the timely, efficient and accurate gathering of data with a variety of semi-automated fixed aerial imaging platforms.

The Flight Operations Manager will hire and train the flight crew, manage logistics, aircraft maintenance and department budgets of an on-demand 7 day per week flight operation. The manager will also fly missions as required. Flexibility, excellent communication skills and a constant and never wavering focus on safety are required. This position reports directly to the Director of Operations.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Management
 - Manage logistics, scheduling, personnel, budgets, maintenance, training, reports, flight planning and dispatching
 - Attend and actively participate in management meetings
 - Keep detailed reports
 - Establish and maintain effective working relationships with others
 - Be able to work weekends/holidays as required and participate in extended operations away from base
 - Understand project status and participate in problem resolutions
 - Understand FAA rules for manned and unmanned flight
- Flight
 - Safely operate company aircraft at all times
 - Pilot a plane with less than 2 degrees bank and plus or minus 50 feet of altitude
 - Correlate current weather reports with flight plans in order to make go/no-go decisions
 - Learn the camera system and be able to troubleshoot, install, and maintain it

- Commercial SEL, instrument rating, and second class medical (minimum)
- Interest in flying drones
- Certified Flight Instructor, 1000hrs TT, 250hrs XC
- 2yrs. Professional Pilot experience

- Excellent interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills
- Knowledge of aircraft mechanics in order to assist in maintenance activities
