Flight Operations Pilot

Fly with a remote sensing leader in the Northwest. We have an immediate need for a Flight Operations Pilot to fly single-pilot remote sensing operations in company owned Mooney aircraft. The success of the business depends on safety, teamwork, and the timely, efficient, and accurate gathering of data with a semi-automated fixed aerial imaging platform.

A pilot for Eagle works on-demand as determined by weather and the needs of the customer. The pilot will be responsible for balancing the need for conducting a safe flight while efficiently gathering data via a custom multi-camera system. Endurance, flexibility, and good communication skills are a necessity to handle varying demands. Pilots can expect to log 200 to 300 hours during the season. The company work environment and philosophy is one of openness and inclusiveness where the PIC has final call on fly/no fly decisions.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Safely operate company aircraft at all times
- Pilot a plane with less than 2 degrees bank and plus or minus 100 feet of altitude while imaging
- Correlate current weather reports with flight plans in order to make go/no-go decisions
- Keep detailed reports
- Establish and maintain effective working relationships with others
- Be able to work weekends/holidays as required and occasionally travel overnight
- Participate in FAA required aircraft maintenance activities
- Participate in flight planning and dispatching
- Understand project status and participate in problem resolutions

Skills and Qualifications Required

- Commercial SEL, instrument rating, and second class medical (minimum)
- 700hrs TT, 200hrs retract
- Experience with Microsoft Office and basic computer knowledge/skills
- Excellent interpersonal, organizational, and communication skills
- Knowledge of aircraft systems

Compensation

- Salary: from \$5000 per month depending on experience
- This is a seasonal position normally from April to the end of September
